Funds are distributed to the local Maui office of the National Kidney Foundation of Hawaii. NKF-Hawaii works hard to provide our residents with free early disease testing, prevention and intervention programs to help reverse or delay kidney failure, support programs for kidney patients and their families; and, to increase the availability of both life saving Kidneys and other organs for transplantation.

The Need is Urgent and Significant in Hawaii - Are you the 1 in 7?
The rate of Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) and kidney failure in Hawaii is 30% higher than the national average. On Maui and throughout Hawaii, Chronic Kidney Disease affects 1 in 7 adults. This translates to a total of 40 million people Nationwide and almost 200,000 residents in Hawaii.

Diabetes, high blood pressure and family history are leading causes of CKD. Native Hawaiians, Filipinos and Japanese are at increased risk for Chronic Kidney Disease. Because CKD is a silent disease, by the time you notice the symptoms your kidneys are usually either badly damaged or already in renal failure.

There are over 2,000 people in Hawaii waiting for a life saving kidney transplant or undergoing dialysis to stay alive.
